NEW FAITH LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADULTS IN THE DIOCESE OF YOUNGSTOWN

The Office of Faith Formation and Lay Ecclesial Ministry of the Catholic Diocese of Youngstown offers new online and in person opportunities for adults seeking to learn more or deepen their understanding of topics in faith and Catholic Church practice. The online sessions allow flexibility in schedules because learners can read, reflect, and respond at any time of the day. Materials are provided and assignments posted at the beginning of a given week, and participants have the week to respond, until the following week's learning is posted. The in-person sessions allow group discussion and immediate feedback. Courses vary in the number of weeks. from three to fourteen. PRAYER OF LOVE


God the Father, You created me in love. Jesus, your love for me compelled you to come to earth to die for me.


