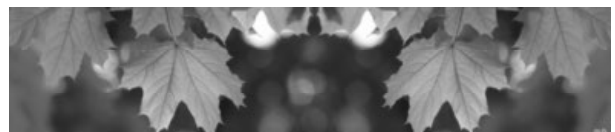


SECOND COLLECTION FOR THE RETIREMENT FUND FOR RELIGIOUS
