HISTORY OF HOLY SPIRIT PARISH

On September 11, 1977, the first Mass was offered at Citizens Savings Bank in Uniontown in their room available for use by the community. A community of 93 people attended this Mass. In Fr. Murray's letter inviting all area residents to this Mass, he was quoted as saying, "It is time for us to step out in faith and establish a mission north of North Canton under the patronage of the Holy Spirit". Immediately, it became the church of the Holy Spirit. Fr. Murray, Fr. John Banks, and Fr. Richard Maro of St. Paul's, North Canton, celebrated the liturgies and tended all the spiritual needs of the people at Holy Spirit.
