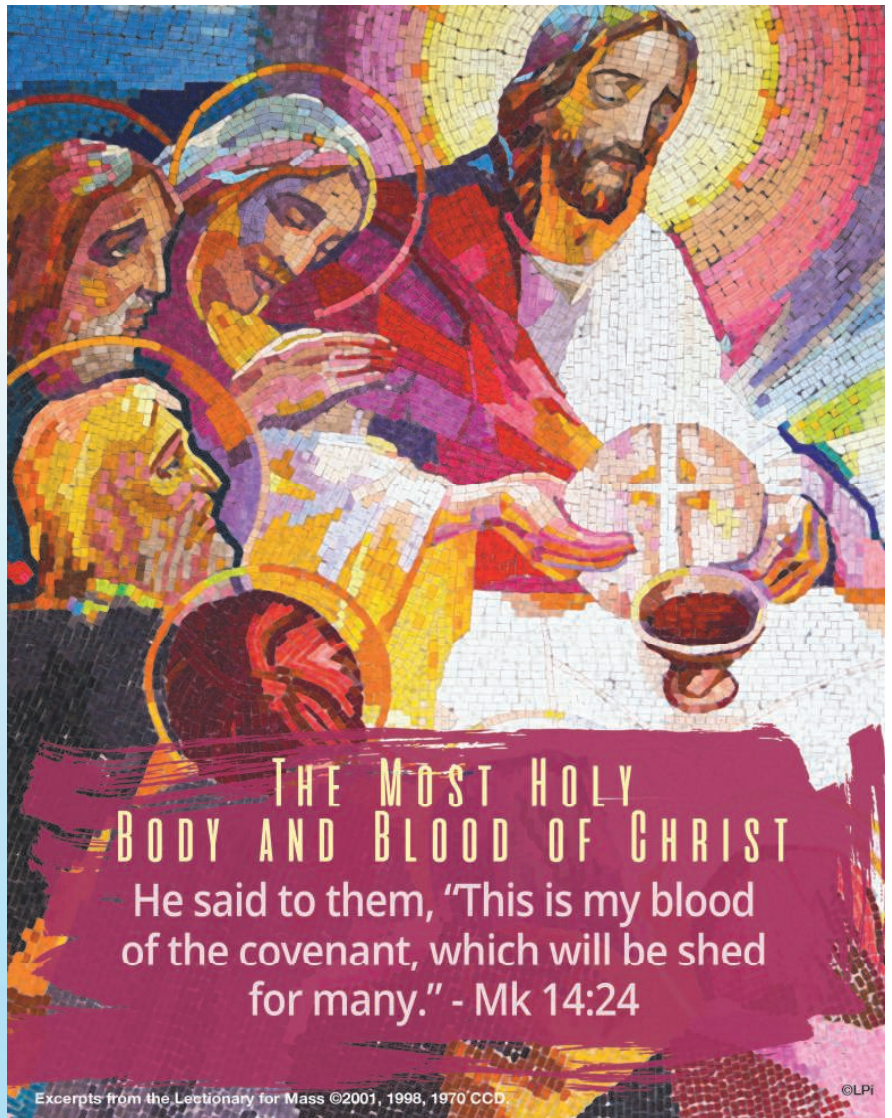

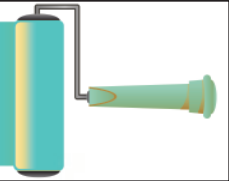
- *ReFit* continues on *Mondays* at **7:00 pm**. Please join us even if you have not yet come to a class.
