RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WEEK

Religious Freedom Week is from **June 22 - 29**. Join Catholics across the country to pray and act for the freedom to serve faithfully and with integrity. People of faith are committed to serving others in God's love in healthcare, child welfare, migration and refugee resettlement, education, and more. Religious freedom protects the space in which we can continue to serve.

An area of concern this year is religious freedom for child welfare service providers. The Federal Child Welfare Provider Inclusion Act (HR 1881 / S 811) would protect the religious liberty of child welfare service providers, including adoption and foster care agencies. Similar legislation has been introduced and passed in several states. All are encouraged to check out the USCCB Action Alert Center and state Catholic conference websites for legislative updates on this and other important policy issues!

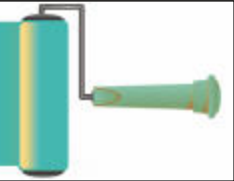
