2018 HOLY CROSS STREAM EXPRESS SUMMER CAMP

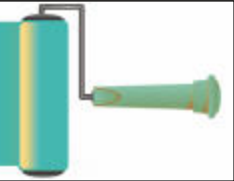

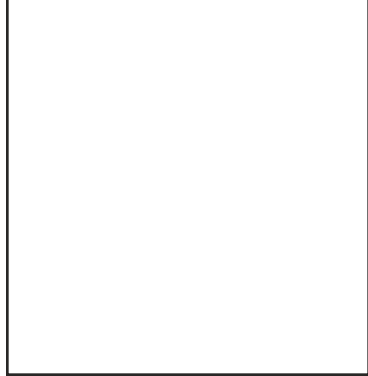
