In the last fifty years, there has been significant progress in modern methods of Natural Family Planning which are scientifically researched methods based on observation of the naturally occurring signs and symptoms of the fertile and infertile phases of a woman's menstrual cycle. 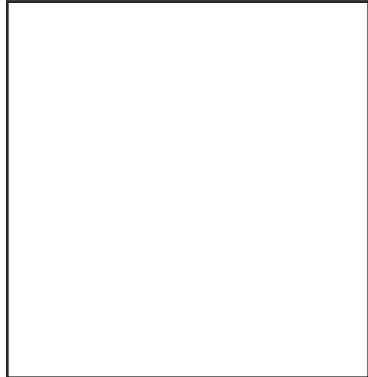
