

Details about First Communion Celebrations

- **Attire:** Boys -- dark pants, white shirt and tie (no jackets or vests, please), dark socks, dress shoes
Girls -- white or pastel dress; veil or other head piece is optional, dress shoes (no gloves)
- **Seating:** Seating will only be reserved for the children and their immediate families, so encourage your guests to arrive early. Immediate family is defined as parents, first communicant, and siblings of first communicant.
- **No flash photography during ceremony** - In order to preserve the solemnity of the occasion, please do not use flash cameras and only video tape from your seats. Please remind your guests of this. At this time, no professional photography will be provided.
